Caution - Watch That Speed!

Keep a close eye on your speed! Many roadside inspections are initiated as a result of going over the speed limit. Even a few miles per hour over will increase your chances. Most importantly, you are required to conform to 392.6, Schedules to confirm with speed limits in the FMCSRs. Your safety and the motoring public are of utmost importance! Drive safe and watch that speed!

When Planning Your Trip Take Note of Any Tolls



Did you know that most toll bills include hefty administrative fees? A \$10.00 toll can easily become \$60.00 just like that. Plan to pay your tolls to avoid unnecessary fines. Run tolls frequently? Consider obtaining an EZPass account to avoid having to stop each time. You work too hard to throw away money on added fees!

T.W.I.C. Cards

Are you planning to go to a port? Make sure you have your T.W.I.C. (Transportation Workers Identification Card) with you. Please note, not all ports are accessible so before you book your load, please call Safety to make sure the company is registered and your information is pre-entered to lessen your wait time.

FSMA Reminder

FSMA (Food Safety Modernization Act) requires specific training prior to hauling certain food related loads. If you haul or plan to haul any type of food product please contact Driver Services so they can assign a quick online course to you. Be Aware of Lane Restrictions

While most states don't have statewide laws prohibiting trucks from the left lane, all states regulate it in some way. States also have different definitions for what constitutes a "truck"; some count axles and others specify weight limits or vehicle descriptions. Even if there is no statewide law prohibiting trucks in the left lane, local governments may impose these restrictions on certain roadways and highways. All states specify the penalties and fines you'll face for violating these laws. Plan your travel and keep an eye out for lane restriction changes throughout your travels. Don't get caught with unnecessary CSA points and fines!
